

UNIFORM GUIDELINES

We expect Northcote College uniform will be worn correctly and with pride.

SCHOOL UNIFORM YEARS 9 - 12

Northcote College uniform is worn by students in Years 9, 10, 11 and 12.

Correct uniform is to be worn at school, to and from school, and at all school functions. All uniform must be tidy, clean and in good repair.

Parents and students may select items from the list provided. No other items, including sports team uniform, may be worn with the school uniform. Uniform items are available to purchase from Yarnton's, Birkenhead.

- Short or long sleeve shirt (tailored or plain style)
- Navy Shorts
- Navy Skirt
- Navy school jacket
- Black shoes (refer below)
- School Beanie

- Navy Fleece
- Navy Trousers
- Navy Sarong/Tupenu/Lava lava
- Black belt
- Black socks or Black opaque tights
- Plain navy cap or bucket hat

STUDENT APPEARANCE

- Facial hair is to be neatly trimmed
- T-shirts worn under uniforms are not to be visible
- Skirt lengths are to be modest.

HAIRSTYLES

- Hair styles must not be extreme
- Hair is to be a natural human hair colour
- Long hair must be tied up for Health & Safety reasons in a workshop or laboratory and whenwearing the No.1 uniform
- Plain navy blue or black headbands may be worn.

JEWELLERY AND NAIL POLISH

- Students are allowed to wear a watch
- Ear piercings are restricted to one small plain stud in each ear
- No facial piercings are permitted except for one small plain nose stud
- Necklaces should not be visible
- Only natural or pale coloured nail polish may be worn.

FOOTWEAR

- Plain black (no colour), low heeled, low cut, shoes are required with uniform. No boots or sports boots are to be worn
- Students may wear black roman sandals without socks
- Shoes with a closed heel and toe must always be worn in any laboratory or workshop.

SPORTS UNIFORM

- The Northcote College PE Uniform must be worn by all Year 9 12 students during PE classes
- Year 13 students participating in PE classes may wear a suitable t-shirt and shorts
- Students playing sport for Northcote College must wear the correct and complete sports uniform appropriate for team/discipline they are representing.

FORMAL (NO. 1 UNIFORM)

The formal or No. 1 uniform is only worn by school prefects or students representing the school at external formal events.

When representing Northcote College and wearing the formal school uniform, the following uniform requirements apply:

- School blazer
- White collared shirt
- Navy School Skirt
- Black leather shoes
- Long hair must be tied up
- Shoes must be flat
- No nail polish

- School tie
- Black dress trousers
- Navy Sarong/Tupenu/Lava lava
- Black socks or Black opaque tights
- Minimal jewellery (plain ear studs and watch)
- Canvas shoes are not acceptable
- Facial hair must be neatly trimmed

YEAR 13 DRESS CODE

Acceptable presentation will be tidy, clean, conservative and show respect for other people's values.

This precludes wearing:

- garments with offensive material on them
- garments advertising alcohol, cigarettes or drugs
- dresses/tops without straps
- showing bare midriffs
- singlets with large armholes
- clothing that is torn/frayed.

All other guidelines regarding student appearance, hairstyles, footwear, jewellery and nail polish apply.
